




 Show you how to use Animoto to create slideshows with your pictures and video clips

Step 3 = Upload your content, put


in order, add text

iterate


Step 5 = Produce

Step 6 = Share the results




- Animoto makes creation of videos easy to do & to share
- To do
  - About 100 pre-designed templates (we cannot modify these)
  - They offer musical tracks already licensed for our use
  - They limit video clip duration to 10 seconds
- To share
  - Links back to your Animoto library
  - Integration with other services
  - You can download & use as you wish


# Step 2 – Logon & Pick Template




### Step 3 – Upload & arrange




## Step 4 – Preview & iterate

- Length of slideshow is driven by music
  - Select shorter or longer music track
  - Adjust general duration of photo presentation
- You can always edit your slideshow
  - Auto saved before publishing
  - Publishing locks the finished slideshow
  - When you edit a published slideshow, Animoto automatically makes a copy to edit; you never have to worry about writing over a published slideshow
