

Agreement Between Dataw Visual Arts Club and Carolina Sports Care

Dataw Visual Arts Club offers its Members an opportunity to begin or expand their artistic journey via workshops. This requires us to secure instructors/teachers who may charge a class fee.

When VAC offers a class with an instructor who charges a fee per student of \$100 or more, not including materials, 10% of the class fee on a per-student basis will be paid by VAC or the instructor to Carolina Sports Care.

VAC will handle class registrations, and payments will be made directly to VAC or the artist. Depending on that exchange, VAC or the artist will issue a check to Carolina Sports Care for **10% of the class fee, excluding any material costs. Payment will be made to Carolina Sports Care (CSC) within two weeks of the conclusion of the class.** This allows for cancellations and time for VAC or the instructor to collect fees and pay CSC.

Example 1: Sue Smith offers a two-day workshop to VAC Members, "Drawing for Beginners." The cost per student is \$125 for the class and \$25 for materials. Therefore, the total cost per student is \$150.

VAC secures date and time through the Community Center and advises on class fee structure, how much the instructor fee is and how much is for materials. Six (6) people sign up for the class directly with VAC or the teaching artist. Students pay VAC or teaching artist. Within two weeks of the conclusion of the class, VAC or the teaching artist pay CSC as follows:


Six Students @ \$150 minus \$25 in materials = \$125 x 6 Students x 10% = \$75 due to CSC

Example 2: Sue Smith offers a one-day workshop for VAC Members, "Intro to Basket Weaving." The cost is \$80 per student plus \$40 for materials, \$120. No fee is due to CSC as the cost, minus materials, is less than \$100 per student.

This agreement shall begin with all classes that are set up and arranged with artists after January 1, 2023
